Growing up in a Christian home, Daisy accepted Christ as her personal Savior and was currently affiliated with Live Oak Missionary Baptist Church in Moultrie, Georgia, under the leadership of Reverend J.W. Greene, Jr. She was a faithful member and actively involved in church service activities, especially in the Choir and Mother's Board.

Daisy was united in Holy Matrimony to the late Henry L. Lowery, Sr. To this union two children were born; Henry L. Lowery, Jr. of Moultrie, Georgia and Belinda Banks (Johnny) of Moultrie, Georgia. Daisy was later married to Arthur Kemp, to this union one child was born; Ronald T. Kemp who preceded her in death.

Daisy Kemp experienced the joy of growing up with siblings; two sisters, and two brothers; two sisters, Bertha Shingles and Betty Ruth Tyson and one brother, Bobby Lee Shingles preceded her in death. She will be fondly remembered but her brother, Leo Shingles of College Park, Georgia.
